Dinner Meeting Notice

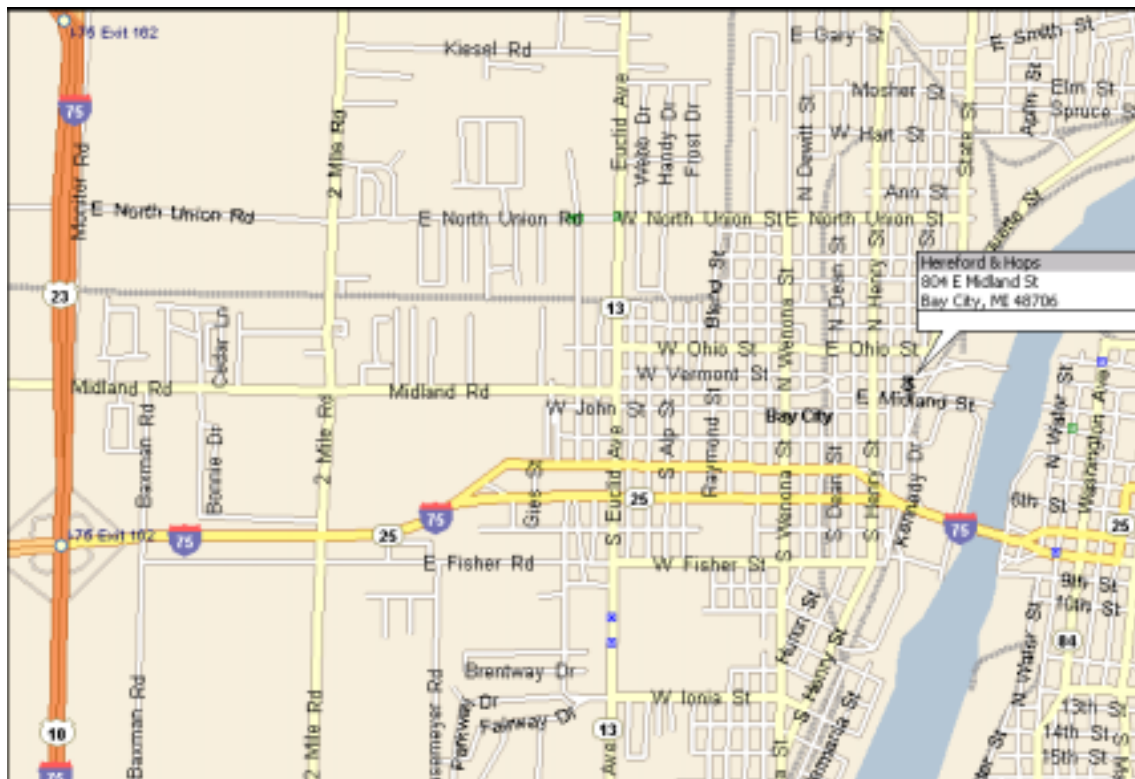
Date: Wednesday, October 10, 2001
