Topic: **Monitoring Your Suppliers**

Speaker: Tom Schoenfeldt

Standards, requirements, and a new scorecard for monitoring suppliers, especially within ISO/TS 16949:2002.

About the Speaker ...

Thomas I. Schoenfeldt is the President of Schoenfeldt Services, Inc., a consulting firm helping companies with Supplier Management issues and Quality System Development. He is sought out for speaking and training opportunities internationally. With more than 30 years experience in a variety of industries in the US and SE Asia, he has a well-rounded understanding of business and how each area of a company looks at a project.

He is an active in both the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) and American Society for Quality (ASQ). Within ASQ, he is a Fellow, Vice Chair for Section Affairs within the Greater Detroit Section, and Treasurer for the Customer Supplier Division (CSD), where Tom has served as a Subject Matter Expert for the CSD since 1999. Currently, he is also a member of ASQ's Technical Program Committee for The World Congress on Quality and Improvement.

Tom was honored as Quality Professional of the Year in 2002 by the Automotive Division of ASQ. He is a contributing author of two books: Supply Management Handbook for the Institute for Supply Management (McGraw-Hill) and The Certified Quality Manager for ASQ. He also received the R. A. (Rick) Maass Award from the CSD of ASQ in 2006 for his publications and presentations in the area of Customer-Supplier Relations.

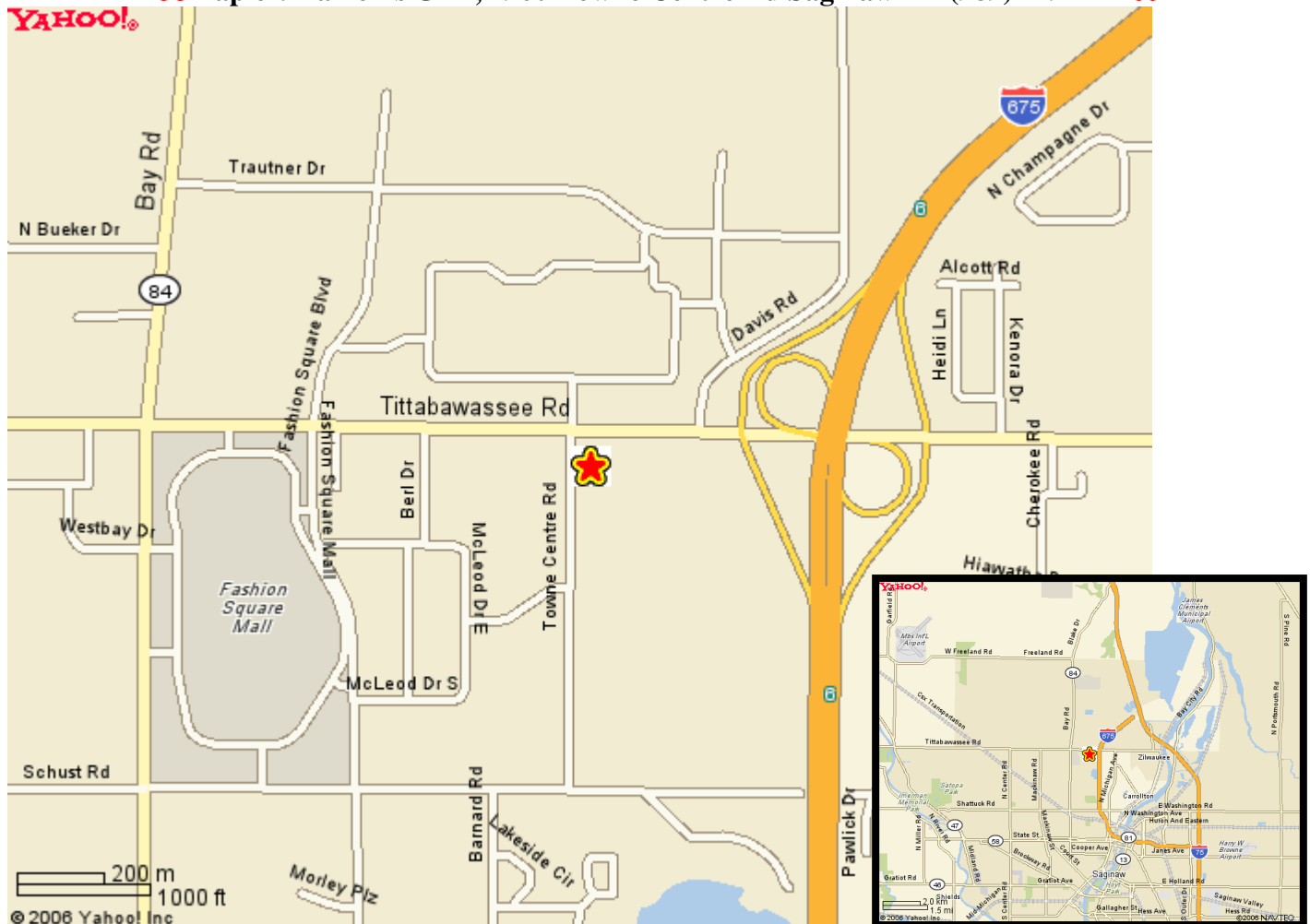
At Madonna University (Livonia, MI), Tom is on the Board of Directors of the Angileri Quality Institute as well as the Business Advisory Committee and the Curriculum Development Committee for the School of Business. He was the Chair of the Planning Committee for the first Annual Conference in Michigan on Quality in 2000 and continues to serve on that committee. He also served on the Board of Examiners for the Michigan Quality Council (MQC), utilizing Malcolm Baldrige criteria, from 1996 to 2004 and chaired their planning committee for the MQC Spring Sharing Conference for two years. Finally, he is a guest lecturer at Michigan State University in the Chemical Engineering Department.

Tom has a BS in Chemical Engineering from Penn State University and has continued his education both formally and informally throughout his life.
